### Footnotes

SOUTHBEACHSANDY off to a sharp beginning, easily cleared the competition en route to establishing command, rated kindly on the front, from the rail, while cutting the fractions, drew out to a sizeable advantage after being let out in upper stretch and held sway, under hand urging to the end. THIS HARD LAND was steadied after being bumped by MASTER SPLASH leaving the gate, took up residence along the rail briefly before swinging into two path soon afterwards, sat well reserved at or near the rear of the pack for nearly three-quarters pole, began to gather up speed after asked for some run approaching the five-sixteenths pole, settled to be four wide at the head of the stretch before commencing to rally in earnest, gained readily thereafter, en route for the place. GREELEY'S LAW tucked along the inside early during the run around the opening bend, saved ground thereafter, nudged aside a tiring rival, while slipping past, in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, then launched a rail rally to be along for the show. GOLDENSTATEWARRIOR three wide around both turns, had no kick. MASTER SPLASH came in, bumping with the runner up at the start, recovered in short order and assumed a forward position, contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside until the quarter pole, failed to keep pace after turning for home and weakened steadily during the final furlong. THERE GOES MOLLY saved ground, was urged on the far turn but still failed to menace. NUB THROWER raced along the outside and tired. KNOCK QUIETLY off the inside, was through after completing three-quarters.
