NO QUESTIONS lagged well back in the early stages, advanced in the three path midway on the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole and unleashed a powerful late run to win going away. MANCHILD settled in the three path for a half, swung four wide and close late to narrowly gain the place. BROOK DANCE pressed the pace in the two path, gained a brief lead in midstretch and yielded late. PAX lunged in the air at the start and bobbled slightly, raced in traffic on the far turn, angled three wide on the turn and rallied mildly. DRIVEN BY SAARLAND was under a firm hold along the rail to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. SAL PARADISE set the pace on the rail, dueled into midstretch and gave way. SCORPER checked slightly between horses early, was well in hand in traffic on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. CENTURY GOLD never reached contention. HOT TO TROT (ARG) pressed the early pace three wide, angled in on the turn and saved ground while tiring in the stretch.
