## **Footnotes**

WARRIOR JAMES broke towards the outside, was put to a strong hold and pulled off BURNING FLAME in time to prevent any significant contact, bumped with RAMBLING holding his spot along the three path coming to the end of the backstretch, drifted a bit to the outside allowing the previously-mentioned opponent access to it soon afterwards, ranged up leaving the three-eighths pole and vied for command as the widest of a foursome, edged past the inner trio to grab a narrow advantage and lead the field into the lane, steadily extended the margin under good handling. STONELESS argued for command from along the inside, was under some encouragement departing the backstretch, had another pair join the dispute late on the turn and remain in the fight until upper stretch, failed to keep up with the top one but held on well enough to secure second. IRON CAFE put to solid urging nearly from the get-go, never made it out of the back of the pack throughout the initial half, swung four wide into the stretch and went to grab the show award. RAMBLING under a firm hold proceeding down the backstretch, bumped with the winner trying to take up position in the three path, the occurring in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was ceded some ground by that same foe a few strides after the incident, underwent a three wide chase, doing so from between rivals during the later stages of the run around the bend, tired after entering the stretch. BURNING FLAME vied for the lead from the outside, kept up the pursuit from between rivals from the five-sixteenths marker to upper stretch, gave way.
