Footnotes

ARTIST COLONY two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide in upper stretch, rallied steadily gaining in the final sixteenth to collar the leader in the final strides and prevail. CROSS GATE vied early on between foes from the two path, took command at the seven-sixteenths, edged away under urging through the turn, shook clear a furlong out under a drive, dug in getting leg weary inside the final seventy yards and was caught in the final strides while clear of the rest. ECONOMIC FORECAST pressed the pace three wide early on, chased between foes through the turn coming under a ride at the three-eighths pole, offered up a mild bid to the final furlong before weakening in the late stages while holding for the show honors. IMRELOADED broke awkwardly, ranged up four wide in close pursuit into the far turn urged along from the three-eighths pole, challenged the leader to the quarter pole, gotten shaken off straightening away, bid mildly to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. BALTIC COAST urged along from the start, vied briefly along the inside until displaced at the seven-sixteenths, faded under a drive through the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened. ADVANCEANDRETREAT chased four to five wide throughout from towards the rear and was never involved. PRINTER'S ALLEY hustled along early on, got detached from the main body of the field running greenly early and was no factor.
