MCCARREN PARK the innermost of a threesome spread across the track in a straight line vying for the early lead, went at it one on one with SACRED SUCCESS before reaching the end of the backstretch, fought for command towards the two path, turned for home and drifted wider into the stretch, with the nemesis following suit, had that rival back away in short order only to get put to the challenge by the runner up almost immediately afterwards, fought with vigor to defend a narrow margin, was given some left handed stick work in the late stages, came out at least two paths, taking the second place finisher outward as well and held on safely. ANN'S SMART DANCER near the two path, chased the embattled pair around the bend, was put to stronger handling and commenced the stretch drive five wide, latched on to the winner and remained directly alongside the rest of the way to the finish line, got herded out slightly in deep stretch and was denied. EXPRESSION took the inside route down the backstretch, swung outward and wider and wider during the next quarter until in the six path by the top of the lane, observed the errant ways of the front runners approaching the furlong marker and ducked over to the rail in reaction to their waywardness, got outfinished. SACRED SUCCESS contested the pace primarily three wide for a half and gave way. THISIZSPARTA off the inside, was guided over to the rail in upper stretch, had no rally.
