**Footnotes**

INSIGHTING just off the pace just off the inside, advanced on the front from midway on the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into the stretch, rallied to match strides with WOOD ON THE FIRE taking over a furlong out, inched away in the late stages to prevail. WOOD ON THE FIRE cut the pace from the two path, shifted to the rail at the seven-sixteenths, had the aforementioned rival take closer order nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner roused for home, dug in battling head to head and was displaced on the front a furlong out, fought on inside clear of the rest for the place. PEGASUS TIGER two to three wide in aim of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, was unable to keep pace with the top pair isolated through the stretch in the show spot, kept on mildly clear of the rest. CHANG'S SECRET lost his footing slightly at the start, tracked the pace along the inside in mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, offered no response. CENTRIPITAL leapt at the start getting off half a beat slow, settled just off the inside towards the rear, got asked and angled at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, weakened in the stretch. BOB AND JIM three to four wide chasing from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. IT WAS ALL GOOD hit the near side stall at the start, raced three to four wide towards the rear and made no impact. HARSH chased the pace three to four wide in range of the front, came under urging three furlongs out, faded through the latter portion of the turn and tired.
