DA VINCI pressed the pace, bid between rivals on the far turn and dug in determinedly inside through the final furlong. MONEY IN MOTION raced three wide throughout, bid on the far turn, briefly put a head in front in upper stretch and came up second best. RED BENDEL was outrun early, came wide and gained mildly. FREUDIAN THERAPIST set the pace, dueled on the turn and weakened. THOMAS HILL raced off the pace inside and had no rally. MUSTER UP raced between foes and tired. HAPPY HIGH tracked inside, then between rivals and faded.
