Footnotes

OPALITE rode the rail on the opening turn, swung outward approaching the backstretch, was taken in hand and eased back after halfway along it, re tucked along the inside route at the half mile pole, but didn't stay there too long, tipped outward until three wide a furlong later, closed in on the front runners making his presence felt by the quarter pole, fought for the lead as the widest of three from upper to midstretch, forged to the front at the eighth pole, then drew off in the late stages, crossing the finish line under a brisk hand ride. CLEVER COOKIE along the outside, became a bit rank midpoint on the first turn, was put to a snug hold initially, and after that didn't work out got steadied, became more professional soon afterwards, started the chase three wide on the far turn but was closer to the rail by the five-sixteenths marker, had the winner arrive on the scene, challenged from between rivals from the quarter pole to mid lane, got shaken off but continued onward in a willing manner to be second best. GOLD LADY lunged up at the break, grabbed a slight advantage and was guided over to the rail, showed the way from there facing honest pressure, had it increase significantly nearing the quarter pole and got turned loose, vied with another pair for an additional furlong then gave way. BIRD MANOR bumped at the start, was strung out three wide on the opening bend, rushed up four wide early down the backstretch, got to about to a length off the leader before backing away, fell back even more entering the second turn and tired. KISS AN ANGEL, got bumped at the start, chased the pacesetter from the outside until midway on the far turn, ducked over to the rail and faltered.
