SWIFT TAYLOR settled into a forward position soon after the start, sat reserved within range of the front runners from off the inside, moved up willingly to become the primary pursuer once LOVE IS KEY KAZ displaced PEGASUS SAPHIRE on the front end nearing the end of the backstretch, challenged the new leader in earnest as the third fraction was being recorded, had the battle spill over into the stretch, had just edged away from that opponent when the runner up drew abreast at the eighth pole, appeared vulnerable at that juncture, but dug in stubbornly to preserve a slim margin the rest of the way to the wire. FUNNY MONEY strung out four wide on the opening bend, travelled three wide on the subsequent one, was let out a notch and won the race with LUVACAT to secure the three path for entrance into the stretch, altered inward in upper stretch, went on to split rivals and burst upon on the scene as a bold threat with an eighth to go, dueled with the winner from there to the end but couldn't go by. LUVACAT off the inside, was under a drive by the three-sixteenths pole, held on well enough to take the show. LOVE IS KEY KAZ was swung into the two path entering the backstretch, got let out a notch and after splitting rivals went to take command at the midway point, cleared sufficiently and was guided over to the rail by the half mile pole, felt pressure soon from the eventual winner, arrived at the five-sixteenths pole on nearly even terms, was asked for run and sparred intensely with that foe until midstretch, yielded for good and backed away. MCGILLYCUDDY'S GAL darted sharply over to the inside after the start, appeared a bit eager nearing the beginning of the backstretch, came within range of another's heels and had the pilot steady attempting to tone down that keenness, continued along the inside route for nearly three-quarters, was put to urging coming four wide into upper stretch, lacked the needed response. PEGASUS SAPHIRE the early leader setting the pace from the rail, retreated after relinquishing. MS. STARELLA three wide on first turn, folded.
