Footnotes

FLYING ZEALOUS broke well and took charge in the early stages, sat entrenched in the two path cutting the pace on a loosely-contested lead, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before finally getting asked for any kind of response, fended off the runner up in the late stages to preserve the decision. VERBOSITY chased from the outside, was already a right handed whip swinging four wide into the stretch, got straightened away and came home with good energy to procure the place. MINESWEPT underwent a ground-saving journey and was outfinished. ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND placed three wide at the head of the stretch, had no response. WON GREAT CLASSIC pursued the winner along the inside route in the initial stages, was taken outward and resumed doing so from the three path around the turn, got called upon entering the stretch, failed to fire and gave way. FIGHT FOR V L T'S stumbled badly at the start with his face touching the ground twice in rapid succession as a result, raced from off the outside, was basically under a gallop throughout.
