REAL ESTATE sat reserved in the two path, entered the stretch and was put to encouragement, gained ground gradually on the front runners, altered course a couple of paths towards the middle of the strip shortly after the incident in deep stretch, kicked into his best stride and got up. MAJESTIC NUMBER sat forwardly placed in the three path off a pair, hooked up with BEAR'S SPIRIT upon reaching the top of the lane, with BUCKEYE HEART joining in on the fracas down along the fence, was carried out slightly by the surviving pace combatant in the late stages, battled hard to the end, grabbing the place award right at the finish line. BEAR'S SPIRIT argued for command while taking the inside route, drifted into the two path arriving at the head of the lane, had

BUCKEYE HEART avail of the newly-created rail passageway and link up with the tussle for the top, clung to a sliver of an advantage from between rivals, lugged in near the sixteenth pole, bumping hard and throwing the last-named rival off his best stride, continued onward now drifting outward a bit after being pulled off the previously bothered foe, taking the runner up along for an abbreviated ride, wound up getting nipped by another twosome. STARSHIP CAPTAIN underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, lacked a solid late response. BUCKEYE HEART made it over to the inside leaving the backstretch, launched a rail bid entering the stretch, was locked in a three-way fight for the lead, when put in tight by BEAR'S SPIRIT with a sixteenth remaining, was immediately eliminated from contention after bumping soundly with that foe. SUPERIORITY tipped into the four path at the five-sixteenths pole, was getting out turning for home, requiring corrective pressure from the right side by the pilot. STRAIGHT FAX saved ground early, fanned into the five path racing through the furlong grounds, had no rally. MARQUET REBEL was sharply angled over to the rail after a sluggish beginning, failed to be a factor off the subsequent ground-saving journey. SUILLEABHAIN three wide at the three-eighths pole, was never involved. BEER IS GOOD sparred for control from the two path, began to back away spinning into the stretch, then was vanned off after returning to the paddock. Following a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the stretch drive, as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of BUCKEYE HEART against the rider of BEAR'S SPIRIT, the latter was disqualified from third and placed fifth for causing interference.
