Footnotes

SHIPWRECKED tucked over to the rail soon after entering the first turn, showed the way, being rated, drifted out enough during the later stages of the run the second bend to be two wide for the commencement of the stretch, lost little if any of her advantage during the ensuing furlong, got switched over to some left hand stick work near the eighth pole, came out gradually but steadily thereafter, wound up crossing over precariously into the two path being used by a fully asked and full of run EFFINEX with about seventy yards, leading its pilot to steady and lose momentum for a stride, dug in well the rest of the way home to reach the finish line first. EFFINEX strung out three wide on the opening bend, was hung out one path wider on the subsequent one, responded positively when let out a notch at the half mile pole to reach a good striking position a quarter down the road, spun into the lane, made minimal progress from upper to midstretch, began to inch her way forward thereafter, was fully extended and nearly latched on to the unofficial winner when forced to steady just off that rival's heels past the sixteenth pole, recovered with good courage to continue to make up ground during the last few jumps. GINGEE tracked the front runners from the inside and got outfinished. NO NUKES bobbed at the start, raced from off the inside throughout, was mostly three wide on the far turn, weakening after swinging into the stretch. ROYAL POSSE shied inward after getting steadied to elude an incoming opponent at the start, saved ground early and failed to menace. HERE HE FITZ in a bit leaving the starting gate, was yanked on the right rein and pulled away from the nearest opponent, gave chase primarily two wide for three-quarters, spun five wide into upper stretch, made no headway. THE FROOD DUDE lacked the necessary stretch response. WINNITUDE three wide on the opening bend, continued to race from off the inside throughout, got placed six wide in upper stretch, tired. KAEPERNICK stalked from the two path and gave way after going six furlongs. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of EFFINEX against the rider of SHIPWRECKED, the latter was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference in deep stretch.
