Footnotes

TONY'S BACK lunged at the break, narrowing avoiding contact with the left side of the gate, moved up willingly to take up a forward position, was forced to be three wide when BROOKLYN BOUND come off the inside suddenly just prior to reaching the opening bend, circled past that foe and patiently stalked the pacesetter for nearly three-quarters from the outside, bid when ready, soon after departing the backstretch, drew alongside, needed only light coaxing, took off under much stronger handling in upper stretch and drew away from the competition, staying under a hand drive to the end. BEIJING BLUES (ARG) three wide around the second turn, was heavily roused in upper stretch and was along for the place. NO MORE TAXES was placed in the two path midway down the backstretch, sat reserved until nearing the quarter pole, was called upon but got outkicked. CHAMPLEVE urged from the gate, quickly grabbed control, was angled over to the rail a couple of jumps before reaching the first turn, showed the way towards the inside, felt pressure for the initial time about midway during the run around the second bend, had little left to offer by the three-sixteenths pole and tired steadily. BROOKLYN BOUND was moving well as the field neared the end of the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, when forced to tap the brakes, be taken in hand off heels and maneuvered into the two path when CHAMPLEVE crossed over to the inside, gradually worked his way back to the rail down the backstretch, and was through after completing three-quarters. DOCTOR WU was no factor.
