MARILYN'S GUY prompted the pacesetter, at a considerable distance off the inside, and under a firm hold, continued along the same scenario until leaving the three-eighths pole, advanced to bid when given some rein, took charge during the run through the furlong grounds and drew off while being kept busy to the end. WRITINGONTHEWALL broke running and wasted little time to establish command, cut the splits, deliberately placed slightly off the rail at all times, faced a challenge from the top one approaching the five-sixteenths pole, fought well during the next furlong, before losing contact, and had to settle for being second best. DOMINANT JEANNES bumped lightly with INDY SCENT leaving the gate, and proved no match for the top twosome. NO SHENANIGANS urged on the far turn, flattened out. INDY SCENT was lightly bumped at the start, raced widest of the group on the second turn and tired.
