**Footnotes**

ULTIMO PRINCIPE broke alertly and quickly grabbed the early advantage, was pressed by a quartet for much of the way down the backstretch, extended the margin throughout the run around the bend, taking the inside route and with the pilot trying to keep something in reserve, turned for home comfortably in front and was set down, emerged from the furlong grounds holding his biggest advantage, squandered some of it in the late stages, but remained well clear at the end. TALENTED WHIZ unhurried for nearly a half from off the rail, picked up the pace coming to the end of the bend, fanned five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to procure the place. WILLY PAY chased the winner three wide, left the five-sixteenths marker under solid encouragement, got outfinished. SIX FLINGS in the two path, was in a bit tight momentarily shortly after entering the turn, got called upon leaving the midway point, made some progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, then flattened out. SUNSHINE VALENTINO three wide entering the turn, was six wide exiting it, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position by weak and tired ones. RICH HERO was tightly positioned along the rail soon after the start, gained some breathing room before reaching the end of the backstretch, once some outside pressure eased up, tracked the leader while saving ground and faltered. GIMMEANOTHERWINK guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, was no factor. GALAXY KAT stumbled badly at the start, bounced up rapidly from the mishap and secured a forward position, was the closest pursuer to the top one for the opening half, doing so from the two path, needed strong handling by the five-sixteenths pole to try to keep pace, wasn't able to and gave way. SECURITY GUARD rode the rail down the backstretch, flipped to be two wide by the top of the turn, trailed.
