VYJACK away in apparent good order, was grabbed hold and kept at a safe distance off the trouble that befell several of his opponents in the initial stages, came three wide into the backstretch and remained at a considerable distance off the rail, picked up the pace and spun five wide into the stretch, rallied into contention during the run through the furlong grounds, forged his way past WEST HILLS GIANT with less than a sixteenth to go and kicked clear. WEST HILLS GIANT gradually worked his way towards the rail after leaving the gate, had ELNAAWI shy inward as he was doing it, smack into a tightly-bunched grouping of rivals, assumed the lead before arriving at the first turn and was settled along the inside route, cut the pace, lightly coaxed to maintain interest and facing honest pressure, had it intensify nearing the quarter pole and was let out in response, emerged from the eighth pole having slightly extended the advantage, felt the winner's presence a sixteenth later, relinquished but dug in well to preserve the place. ELNAAWI, out a couple of steps, was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest foe at that time, shied inward as the runner up was angling over to the inside after the break, was caught in tight quarters, eventually getting steadied while getting bumped, fought against the bit for a few strides after that happened, was taken four wide into the backstretch and stayed parked out out there on the far turn, held on with good courage down the lane for the show award. SIETE DE OROS in tight quarters, was bumped after the start, raced along the outside, displayed a mild kick en route for the final major check. OVERANALYZE hung out in the four path on the opening bend, travelled three wide on the subsequent one, weakened steadily after entering the stretch. TRANSPARENT got bumped leaving the gate, went on for a little while when caught in tight quarters, resulting in being bumped again, raced three on the first turn to assume the role of primary pursuer, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. AMERIGO VESPUCCI made contact with another a short distance out of the gate, went on to save

ground to no avail. CHAMPION BOY was taken in hand after ONE PASS headed into his direction in the opening stages, saved ground until the quarter pole, neared that station appearing to have some momentum, but was checked cutting the corner into the lane. ESCAPEFROMREALITY in tight quarters making his way to the first turn, got turned sideways after being bumped near his hind quarters, then got clipped from behind, sat forwardly placed along the outside for over six furlongs, was set down to a drive turning for home, gave way. SKY CAPTAIN four wide on the opening bend, was through after going a half. ORE PASS bumped with TRANSPARENT leaving the starting gate, got caught in and amongst rivals and right in the thick of the bumping incident that occurred shortly after the field was sent on its way, was taken hold off after being bumped again, went on for a couple of jumps then clipped the heels of ESCAPEFROMREALITY, raced at or near the back of the pack thereafter, swung five wide into the stretch, had no rally. An objection lodged by the rider of ELNAAWI against the rider of WEST HILLS GIANT alleging interference soon after the start was not allowed.
