**Footnotes**

READTHEPROSPECTUS strung out three wide on the opening bend, sat reserved in midpack until about halfway down the backstretch, was let out a notch and rushed up to confront the runner up, with MAGIC HARBOR likewise on the same mission, only parked one path farther to the outside, had that opponent ease back in short order, chased the pacesetter around the far turn, staying within close range, narrowed in well to cut the margin in half by the quarter pole and was set down, as was BAKER STREET, fought for the lead from between rivals until midway through the furlong grounds, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, slowly but steadily added to the advantage, crossing the wire under a strong hand drive. BAKER STREET took a little bobble with his step out of the starting gate, scurried away from others to establish control, came under heavier pressure after the winner middle-moved down the backstretch, saw the margin dwindle down late on the far turn, spun into the stretch under a drive, sparred with intensity with the top one, yet fell back by a sliver by midstretch, finished willingly to secure second. MAGIC HARBOR travelled three wide on each turn, tipped into the four path entering the backstretch, had the rider commit to rushing up to take on the pacesetter a stride before the top one chose the same course of action, was put to a firm hold and eased back, stayed within contention on the second turn, was put to a drive entering the stretch, got shaken off by the top twosome soon afterwards, held on well enough long enough coming to the finish line to preserve the show. TUG OF WAR off a beat slowly after striking the left side of the starting gate, quickly tucked along the inside, was hard to rate in the initial stages, raced rankly, settled down a bit by the time he reached the backstretch, vacated the rail during the run around the far turn, was already under a drive entering the stretch, closed late, missed out on third. IRISH LION reserved along the outside, was forced to be kept on hold, idling behind rivals from the five-sixteenths pole until upper stretch, failed to fire when given his cue. THIS HARD LAND raced from off the inside, was under a right handed whip coming three wide into the stretch, had no rally.
