Footnotes

PERCUSSION kept at a slight distance, argued to maintain control, had the runner up arrive on the same late on the far turn, went on a little further then got set down, tussled with intensity with the second place finisher, with little separating the pair, dug in with good determination to fend that foe off. MORDI'S MIRACLE three wide on each turn, moved up coming to the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was put to a drive as a protracted duel with the eventual winner commenced, tried valiantly, but couldn't go by. SAILMATE settled into midpack after the start, raced between rivals on the second turn, had the rider glance back prior to ducking over to the inside at the quarter pole, stayed along the rail for the next furlong, altered course to be outside the front runners at the furlong marker, showed some willingness despite failing to gain ground appreciably on them. SOCIALSAUL in the three path on the opening bend, resumed the chase on the top one thereafter a bit closer to the rail, needed some encouragement to keep pace on the far turn, backed away after going six furlongs. ALL OF THE ABOVE departed the backstretch from the three path, failed to reach a contending position. KEEP ME INFORMED saved ground until the quarter pole, was put to a long drive, faltered.
