COUSIN MICHAEL settled inside on the pace early on attended by the well restrained MASTER CIP, conceded that foe the front at the five and a half, shifted outside to the three path at the seven-sixteenths, remained in close pursuit through the turn, got let out nearing the quarter pole, dug in under a drive to take command a sixteenth out, inched away kept to task to prevail. MASTER CIP well held early on attending the pace, took over at the five and a half just off the inside, remained on hold until let out at the quarter pole, dug in fending off his main rival to the sixteenth marker, yielded the front at that station finishing mildly while safe for the place. JONRAH settled in mid pack just off the inside, came under urging three furlongs out progressing through the turn, offered up a mild kick in the stretch to procure the show. SNAP CALL tracked the pace two to three wide, came under urging swinging three wide for home, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. BIG CITY BOY three to four wide in mid pack, got urged along from the three-eighths pole, spun four wide in upper stretch and weakened. TAKE A WALK hesitated at the start, settled three wide towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch and made no impact. SMALL TOWN saved ground throughout and offered little.
