SUMMER APPLAUSE raced along the outside, remained unhurried making her way towards its end, was let out at the beginning of the run around the far turn, tipped outward to be four wide halfway along it and was asked for just a bit more, entered the stretch and took off after the leader in earnest, scooted by to take charge by the eighth pole, continued to edge away, with only an intermittent shot left handed shot interrupting a brisk hand ride. TWICE THE LADY was grabbed hold as SUNNY DESERT was working her way towards the inside nearing the end of the homestretch, swung three wide entering the backstretch, remained as wide on the far turn, got set down spinning into the lane, failed to cut into the winner's margin, but continued on in a willing manner to secure second. SUNNY DESERT unhurried towards the inside in the initial stages, was taken outward gradually upon reaching the far turn, fanned into the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, came home with good energy, missing out on the place. LADY GRACENOTE tucked along the inside route and stayed along it down the backstretch and for a good portion of the way on the second turn afterwards, was put to encouragement and picked up interest nearing the quarter pole, got placed four wide shortly after spinning into the lane, displayed a mild response en route for the last check. SISTERLY LOVE broke outward awkwardly, recovered quickly and powered by rivals using her way own power to assume first a forward position and then the advantage, had a hard-to-rate NATALIE VICTORIA draw abreast soon afterwards, and contently yielded the lead to that rival, kept a watchful eye proceeding towards the half mile pole, took off from that station, with another following along, but from one path further to the outside, went by, showed the way coaxed along in the two path, came under heavy pressure after completing three-quarters, relinquished to the winner in the furlong grounds and gave way. WITHGREATPLEASURE had just tossed her head when the gate was sprung open, went on to come out last after lunging up at the break, was three wide on the opening turn and one lane wider for almost all of way down the backstretch, challenged three wide for control in the vicinity of the half mile pole, kept up the pursuit for the next quarter, had little left by the top of the lane and folded. NATALIE VICTORIA hit the right side of the starting gate, was put to a firm hold by the pilot but appeared headstrong racing three wide for the opening turn, cleared rivals to take up position in the two path then went by last remaining front runner to grab the advantage, was guided over to the inside, showed the way until displaced past the half mile pole and faded.
