### Footnotes

DIVERSA was rated along outside, advanced outside on the second turn, drew away quickly when roused and remained well clear while being kept to the task to the wire. SWEEP DREAMS quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside, proved no match for the winner and stayed on stubbornly inside to earn the place award. STOP FOR SCHNAPPS was rated along outside, angled to the rail leaving the backstretch, put in a run on the second turn, came wide into the stretch but had little left for the drive. ERIN MOOR was rated along inside, angled out and put in a three wide run on the second turn then weakened in the stretch. GAMES OF CHANCE was outrun while racing inside.
