Footnotes

AFRIKANER raced up close along the inside, checked on the far turn, got through along the rail entering the stretch, surged to the front in midstretch and edged clear under pressure. CALL TIGER trailed to the turn, swung five wide and rallied belatedly. VICTORIOUS AFFAIR stumbled at the start, pressed between horses into midstretch and weakened. BROOK DANCE set the pace into midstretch and tired. ESTIMATOR lodged a three wide move on the turn and flattened out. PRESS ONLY raced in hand on the rail, waited on the turn and lacked a further response. NOBLE KING checked at the start, moved out at the half mile pole, rallied four wide on the turn and tired.
