Footnotes

METULLA was outrun for a half, raced behind a wall of horses on the turn, swung three wide to get clear in upper stretch and closed steadily to get up in the final strides. FRENCH TRANSITION steadied along the inside at the three quarter pole, raced in traffic along the backstretch, split horses on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and yielded grudgingly. ACCLIMATE raced wide while well back for a half, made a steady move to threaten nearing the quarter pole and flattened out in midstretch. UNGI BLANC pressed the pace in the two path and drifted out while tiring on the turn. COOL N COLLECTIVE set the pace inside to the turn and gave way. SARATOGA LULABY raced in midpack for a half and faded on the turn. PACKER steadied while rank soon after the start, raced up close between horses to the far turn and gave way.
