WINDAFULL away in good order, quickly established control, settled along the inside route by the end of the homestretch, cut the pace, being rated along by the pilot, with MOST HAPPY FELLA parked in the two path just off his hind quarters, continued along on the same scenario for over a half, edged away from the others prior to the third fraction being recorded, turned for home and was set down to a drive, lost none of his advantage during the next furlong, had the runner up close in rapidly in the late stages, but reached the wire in time to preserve the decision. CAP THE MOMENT raced along the outside, firmly rated to midway on the far turn, was guided over to the rail at that juncture, cut the corner under a drive, stayed glued along the inside route the rest of the way home en route for place honors. FORTITUDE contently tracked the top one while saving ground, was put to solid urging and angled outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, got outfinished. MOST HAPPY FELLA reluctant to load, proceeded to come way without major incident, stalked the winner from along the outside, drifted into the three path late on the far turn, entered the stretch and weakened. WENT THE DAY WELL raced three wide on both turns, was let out a notch departing the backstretch with no pick up speed being noted, got set down to a drive a sixteenth later, with the same result as before, commenced the stretch drive four wide and steadily tired. STAR OF NEW YORK saved ground to the three-eighths pole, trailed.
