Footnotes

IMAGINE TOMORROW five wide prompting a trio inside, came under urging three furlongs out, shook clear from those rivals at the five-sixteenths, edged away to the furlong grounds under a drive then was kept busy to the wire to maintain his advantage. LA WILD SPEED bumped at the start due to pressure from HALO CITY GIRL breaking inwards, settled four wide in mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the place honors. WILD SIREN disputed the pace four wide between foes urged along from the three-eighths pole, came in impeding MINI MUFFIN and HALO CITY GIRL arriving at the quarter pole forcing both those rivals to steady briefly, cut the now unoccupied corner into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. ROCKY FIELD just off the pace just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot for the last major share. ABLE'S SISTER bumped at the start from pressure on the outside, saved ground towards the rear, got ridden along from the three-eighths pole, improved position, spun three wide for home rallying mildly to the eighth pole and offered no further response, flattening out late on. NIGHT READER squeezed out between foes at the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear, got ridden along from midway on the turn and passed tired rivals in the stretch. MINI MUFFIN bumped at the start and carried in by HALO CITY GIRL, hustled away to dispute the pace with a trio, came under urging three furlongs out, was forced to steady briefly nearing the quarter pole as WILD SIREN crossed in front in close proximity and weakened thereafter. HALO CITY GIRL broke in at the start bumping MINI MUFFIN and carrying that foe in for a few steps soon after, disputed the pace

between foes from the three path pushed along from three furlongs out, steadied nearing the quarter pole as WILD SIREN took over the lane and weakened after turning for home. DEVOLUTION tracked the pace from close range urged along from the three-eighths pole, faded in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
