MONSTER MASH put to brisk encouragement, secured the front, was switched over to being rated a couple of jumps before reaching the half mile pole, felt only light pressure from the closest pursuer during the run around the bend, was almost all the way through the furlong grounds before asked for run, drew off. MAKE A FORTUNE chased the winner from the two path and proved no match. CONTICINIO loosely pocketed, failed to muster up a solid response after cutting the corner. FOGGY ROAD saved ground ground, slipped into the two path leaving the midway point on the turn, was soon called upon, failed to offer up a response. DEMON'S DEPUTY travelled three wide on the turn, folded. BUDDYS MOON raced along the outside and was outrun. VELVET CAP three to four wide on the turn, tired. SNEAKY FREUD was never in the hunt.
