NOT SO FAST was rated along outside in the early going, advanced four wide on the second turn, dug in resolutely in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. TARQUINIUS broke awkwardly, was rated along early, was steadied leaving the backstretch, circled five wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get past the winner. PRINCE WAQUOIT raced close up while under stout restraint, rallied inside nearing the stretch, altered course to the outside in deep stretch and finished gamely. PARENTAL PRESSURE quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. SKY APPROVAL was outrun while racing inside early on, rallied into traffic along the inside in upper stretch, altered course to the outside and lacked a solid finishing punch. SALTY NOTE raced close up outside, was four wide on the first turn, three wide on the second turn and tired in the stretch. BILLY HAGGARD raced close up while between rivals, was steadied when in tight quarters in upper stretch, tired and was vanned off after the finish. MR. SINATRA was hustled along early but had no response and tired.
