ALWAYS A HERO was urged along early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, altered course in the drive and was along late from the outside. TAKE ME OUT JOHN raced close up inside, rallied three wide into the stretch and dug in gamely to the wire. CLUSTER BOMB was hustled along outside, rallied three wide on the turn and was outfinished. DYNOMYNT broke awkwardly, was outrun early and had no rally. A. P. LAX showed good speed outside, put in a three wide run on the turn and tired in the final furlong. NAVY HYMN chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. MOSMAN BAY broke slowly and raced greenly while wide throughout. CARSON GUY contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. DON CORLEONE broke slowly, raced greenly and had no rally. MR. THERMALTECH raced inside and tired. CLARKS LANDING tired.
