LEAP DAY set the pace inside to the turn, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and drew off in hand with the rider glancing back while well clear in midstretch. WESTERN DEED was in hand along the rail for five furlongs, angled out midway on the turn and finished willingly for the place. STOPBLUFFING raced well back along the rail, angled out at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. FREDDY THE CAP rushed up along the inside, steadied while rank on the first turn, raced just off the pace along the rail, saved ground for six furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. STORMY SUCCESS was outrun along the rail, steadied and swerved out to avoid the spill at the quarter pole and failed to menace. TYPHOON TYCOON chased three wide and gave way on the turn. COMMISSIONER CHRIS steadied and swerved out to avoid the spill while far back at the quarter pole. OEDIPUS O'NEAL raced in midpack to the turn and swerved out while giving way at the quarter pole and was eased late. SIGH YOU broke down and fell while pressing the winner nearing the quarter pole.
