MEESE ROCKS burst out of the starting gate and grabbed the front in a flash, was rated in the two path while cutting the fractions, was put to intermittent hand encouragement coming to the three-sixteenths pole, after the runner up drew up to her hind quarters at that station, left the furlong grounds, still keeping that opponent safely at bay, then held sway, under slightly more energetic hand rousing from the sixteenth pole to the wire. BIG BROWNIE took the inside route, nibbled constantly on the right side of the bit while being rated along, was put to a drive just past the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner with a burst of speed to reach the top one's left flank by upper stretch, continued on with good energy, but was unable to reel in the winner. LOTS OF STONES rated towards the three path prompting the pacesetter, proved no match. LAYLABEN left the backstretch four wide and failed to reach a contending position. MINERALOGIST three wide at the half pole, tired and was put to light urging from the head of the stretch to the end.
