SENSATIONAL SLAM was herded outward a couple of paths at the start, from pressure initiated by the runner up, recovered in short order and settled in the back of the pack, placed in the two path, was coaxed along to keep pace departing the backstretch, maneuvered to be three wide midway on the turn, responded well when given his cue turning for home, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, closed in well thereafter, collaring the front runners with about seventy yards remaining to prove best. DISKI DANCE broke outward a bit and was taken in hand, but not before causing some crowding leaving the gate, was lightly hand urged to the front, before being placed back to a good hold, once firmly in control, set the splits, rated along the inside and being only mildly pressed, was let out in upper stretch, left the furlong grounds, still the clear leader, dug in with good determination, wasn't able to keep up with the top one when rival arrived on the scene past the sixteenth pole, yielding readily, but refused to let VENGEFUL WILDCAT go by for place honors. VENGEFUL WILDCAT underwent a three wide pursuit and was outkicked. RIFT bobbled shortly after leaving the gate, took up residence along the inside, was asked for run at the three-eighths pole but could make no headway on the front runner. ANOTHER SILVER OAK chased from the outside and gave way.
