MORINE'S VICTORY settled in good position along the backstretch, raced in hand while saving ground for a half, angled three wide at the three-sixteenths pole then drew off under good handling. HEDGE FUND pressed the pace between horses, challenged at the quarter pole, but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. SUNY'S BOY moved out while racing well behind on the backstretch, swung five wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. PIQUANTE CAT dueled along the rail into upper stretch and tired. MR. UMPHREY was never a factor while saving ground. SPIRITON steadied between horses at the half mile pole, lodged a mild bid from outside on the turn and flattened out. EXCEL pressed the early pace between horses, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. EXPLOSIVE COUNT showed only brief speed while four wide.
