WALL STREET WONDER dueled outside to the turn, poked a head in front at the quarter pole, battled noses apart into midstretch, briefly relinquished the lead inside the sixteenth pole then fought back gamely while drifting out a bit to prevail after a hard drive. CUSTOM FOR CARLOS set a pressured pace along the rail for nearly a half, fought gamely nearing the eighth pole, drew even with the winner seventy yards out then drifted out a bit while yielding grudgingly. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS was rated just behind the dueling leaders, was asked for run three wide leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. ELUSIVE WARNING settled just off the pace along the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. CRIMSON COMIC trailed the entire way, swung wide at the quarter pole and lacked a rally.
