CIRES was put to a firm hold after being out sprinted by VICIOUS RAPIDS for the early lead, contently took up the role of stalker, keeping a watchful eye on the aforementioned rival, three wide, bid when ready coming to the quarter pole, went head to head for the lead, apparently getting his nose down in time at the finish line to grab the decision. VICIOUS RAPIDS set the pace from the two path, facing only mild pressure throughout most of the opening half, came under the gun after turning for home, raced as a team with the top one, dug in with good determination but missed. ESTIMATOR rode the rail, swung wide for the stretch run, and gained gradually on the battling top twosome. JALA FEVER placed four wide at the half mile pole, proceeded around the bend under a snug grip, came up empty when asked for a response.
