DOWAGER cut the pace inside in hand, shook away in the far turn under her own power still in reserve, cornered just off the inside for home, got roused under a sole off sided stick a furlong out, went clear under a sustained hand ride to the wire. MARY'S MYSTIQUE bumped at the start by LEGALLY BAY breaking inwards and squeezed back lightly soon after, saved ground towards the rear, remained patiently handled until set down nearing the quarter pole, proved no match for the top one while along for the place honors in the late stages. BI LIGHT OF DAY just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, offered up some belated energy to be along for the show. LEGALLY BAY broke in at the start bumping MARY'S MYSTIQUE and squeezed that foe back against BI LIGHT OF DAY, tracked the pace inside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the final furlong. SUNDAE SCHOOL two to three wide in mid pack, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, spun four wide into upper stretch and weakened. HOPE RULES away well, tracked the pace two to three wide in aim early on, got shaken off a bit into the far turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide at the quarter pole and tired in the drive. TIZALLHEART three wide in pursuit in range early on, faded after a half to the rear, got ridden along from three furlongs out and made no impact.
