WESTERN TRYST was rated from just off the inside while keeping within range of the pacesetter, was given his cue prior to completing the half, angled two to three wide into the stretch, closed in PETE'S FLEET, went by in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away. JACK'S R WILD underwent a ground-saving journey after being sent over to the rail soon after the start, arrived at the sixteenth pole, latched on to the former pacesetter, hesitated in tight quarters down along the fence before slipping by the previously-mentioned foe with seventy yards remaining to garner the place. FROST JORDAN made light contact with LT. KOJAK after coming out of the starting gate, raced from off the inside, mostly towards the three path on the bend, swung four wide under solid encouragement entering the stretch, mustered up a good kick to take the show. TESTOSTERSTONE bumped several times from between opponents as the field was sent on its way, chased the leader two wide on the turn, got shaken off as the half was being completed, held on well for last major check. PETE'S FLEET bumped at the start, made it over towards the rail by the end of the backstretch, momentarily shook free during the later stages of the run around the bend, got reeled in past the eighth pole, weakened steadily in the final sixteenth. SUNRISE LOVER three wide at the three-eighths pole, had no response. DARK ROAST bumped at the start, raced primarily in the two path on the turn, tired then was pulled up quickly. LT. KOJAK brushed with FROST JORDAN after losing his footing at the start and was taken hold of, raced at or near the inside thereafter and trailed.
