UNDERSTATEMENT moved up from outside in the early stages, stalked the pace in hand on the backstretch, lodged a bid closing the gap on the far turn, took command midway on the turn, extended his advantage in upper stretch then drew away under a vigorous hand ride with the rider glancing back while well clear a sixteenth out. NATIONAL PRIDE sprinted clear, set the pace in hand for six furlongs, relinquished the lead midway on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and continued on well to best the others. NITE LIGHT tucked in on the first turn, saved ground for seven furlongs then finished willingly to gain a share. SENIORS PRIDE was rated just outside the top two for five furlongs, gained a bit on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked a late response. MORE THAN A REASON was carried wide on the first turn, continued wide in hand along the backstretch, raced well back to the turn and passed only tiring horses. ATONED raced in midpack between horses and lacked the needed response when called upon. GIANT CHIEFTAN drifted wide early and failed to threaten thereafter. REFLECT TIMES (JPN) saved ground, swung wide and lacked a late response.
