Footnotes

TOCCET'S IMAGE was unhurried while racing along the outside in the initial stages, picked up interest after departing the backstretch, spun three wide into the lane and took off in earnest, closed the gap making his way to the eighth pole, grabbed command in the final seventy yards and edged away under good handling. LA FESTA E DOMANI swung off the rail entering the backstretch, lagged near the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, got asked for a response spinning into the lane and gave it, finishing with good energy to secure second. OASIS OF CHANCE raced three wide around both turns, moved up in unison with BIG FEARLESS to overhaul the former loose leader leaving the midway point on the far turn, raced on nearly even terms with BIG FEARLESS until past the furlong marker, didn't have enough to turn back the winner in deep stretch, weakening eventually into the show slot. BIG FEARLESS patiently stalked the early pacesetter from off the inside, ranged up quickly, together with OASIS OF CHANCE leaving the half mile pole, went by the leader and got hooked up in a duel with the show horse, continued the battle until about a sixteenth to go, got run down by the top pair. GRAMERCY was steadied entering the backstretch, lost momentum and fell back quickly, failed to reach a contending position thereafter. PATENT PENDING TOM three wide on the second turn, never threatened. GREAT RECESSION set the opening splits from the rail and on an open lead, succumbed readily when tested in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole. PERFECT JOISKI came four wide into the stretch and tired. NUMEROUS ONE was through after completing three-quarters.
