STYLE WATCH stumbled at the start, yet still out broke the field, remained in a forward position and disputed the pace from the two path for the opening half, appeared to poke a head in front as the field headed into the stretch, wrestled away the lead for good soon afterwards, then maintained a clear advantage to the end, driving. MY ZEALOUS STORM took over the three path after ANCIENT DEVIL moved closer to the rail leaving the backstretch, ranged up menacingly towards the embattled pair during the later stages of the run around the bend, with the rider sitting chilly aboard, was allowed to settle into upper stretch before released from a firm hold on the reins, finished willingly although unable to dent the winner's margin. CITY VICE sat within striking distance from the outside for the opening half, was angled to be four wide at the three-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top twosome. EUROSENSATION bumped lightly with BRIQUETTE at the start, lacked the necessary stretch response. I'M THE MIZZ three wide at the three-eighths pole, was no factor. LITTLE HALO bobbed at the start, made a rapid recovery, sped to the front and was just as quickly guided over to the inside, argued for control from there with the winner, fell back a sliver as the two front runners reached the quarter pole, kept up the pressure for about another furlong before backing away. ANCIENT DEVIL much wider down the backstretch, settled to be two wide just before reaching the turn, was through after going a half. BRIQUETTE brushed with EUROSENSATION at the start, faded off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
