Footnotes

LIBERTY WING tracked the pace from just off the inside, ranged up at the seven-sixteenths to confront the leader through the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered on even terms, drifted in brushing with his main foe in upper stretch, dug in to the eighth pole inching away to his largest lead, fought on to the wire able to hold that same stubborn rival at bay and prevail. BEELINER broke sharply from the gate, settled on the pace along the inside, got confronted in the far turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered on even terms, got brushed at the head of the stretch as his main foe drifted in slightly, battled on through to the wire in stubborn fashion reasserting himself nearest the finish and missed. UNBRIDLED LOGIC two to three wide towards the rear, commenced a three wide bid from the three-eighths moving into contention at the head of the stretch, rallied willingly through the drive unable to reel in the top pair while securing the show honors. CANDY RAIDER two to three wide in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. TAPE IT broke out slightly at the start and was bumped by MR LIT breaking inwards, saved ground towards the rear, got ridden along from the three-eighths pole, angled three to four wide in upper stretch and made no impact. MR. LIT broke in at the start bumping TAPE IT before being taken off that foe, chased inside from close range, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, faded from prominence and tired.
