THE TRUTH AND K G away in good order, took control before reaching the end of the homestretch, got engaged in an abbreviated duel with NOW AND THEN between calls down the backstretch, had that opponent get asked for some run midpoint on the far turn, lost little if any of the advantage however, basically remaining under a rating hold, entered the stretch and was given his cue, responded positively, drawing away to his biggest advantage at any point of the race by the eighth pole, had the margin cut down piece by piece, drifted out late after being a steady diet of left handed stick work and just held on. GO GET THE BASIL darted over to the inside in the initial stages, rode the rail for the opening six furlongs, left the backstretch and got let out a notch, cut the gap, was asked for more and proceeded to angle outward from the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home three wide by now having been put strong handling, arrived at the furlong marker with full momentum, closed in on the winner in tandem with NOW AND THEN directly to his inside, finished willingly to the end, but fell short. NOW AND THEN stalked the pacesetter from off the inside, moved up readily and raced heads apart with the winner between calls down the backstretch, got eased back and once more patiently stalked the leader, was switched over from being rated and asked for a response slightly more than halfway around the far turn, made no headway, turned for home, reached the eighth pole with the second place finisher abreast, began to narrow in on the top one afterwards, had the front-running rival begin to drift outward, followed suit, al the while continuing to gain ground, was taken in hand prior to the wire. HOOFING CAT raced from off the inside, swung three wide into the backstretch, remained the widest of all making his way to half mile pole, re tucked into the two path at that station, fell back steadily, drifted four wide into the lane and was eased.
