Footnotes

TOE JAM FOOTBALL three wide just in behind the pace settled in mid pack, came under urging when given a seam as IVORY LIGHTNING drifted at the three-eighths in retreat, bid into contention at the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station, rallied with good kick to collar the clear leader a sixteenth out, went on by with little resistance to prevail geared down in the final steps. LUCKY MY WAY on the pace just off the inside after breaking well to cross in front, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths, inched away to the eighth pole with a clear lead, dug in under a drive through the stretch, got collared and displaced at the sixteenth marker while well clear of the rest for the place honors. SHALALA just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, was forced to steady when impeded by GUYANA STAR shutting the path off in front in reaction to the backtracking IVORY LIGHTNING, lost momentum as a result, angled four wide in upper stretch under a drive, offered up late foot to garner the show in a good effort. GUYANA STAR three to four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement between foes at the three-eighths pole, shifted in impeding SHALALA at the five-sixteenths in response to IVORY LIGHTNING retreating, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole then weakened in the late stages. CHUBBALITA'S JOY four wide in pursuit from close range initially, came under urging three furlongs out taking the overland route aided by the drifting out IVORY LIGHTNING, swung three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened in the drive. LAZULITE tracked inside just off the pace coming under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened. HALO'S SURPRISE just off the pace in close pursuit under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, faded through the latter portion of the turn and weakened. LA GAZELLE stumbled at the start then was bumped by IVORY LIGHTNING, settled three wide towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun four wide into the stretch and made no impact. IVORY LIGHTNING broke in at the start bumping LA GAZELLE, came under hustling to be forwardly placed, shied in a few steps soon after forcing LA GAZELLE to be taken in hand briefly in tight, chased three wide under urging in close pursuit, drifted out slightly at the three-eighths to the four path, began to retreat at that station then

tired.
