AMERICAN CREED broke sharply and was eased in hand to attend from the two path, inched up under his own power to take over three furlongs out, came under challenge and was roused at the quarter pole coming under some stick work to the furlong grounds, went clear through the final eighth ridden out to the wire. PILLAR OF STRENGTH chased the pace three wide, advanced under encouragement from the five-sixteenths to threaten the front briefly at the head of the stretch, got shaken off by the top one proving no match while kicking on readily safe for the place honors. SCARE CITY just off the pace just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, kicked along for the show best of the rest. MY UNCLE FRANK just off the inside towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home, passed tired rivals in the stretch. METROPOLITAN STORM tracked the pace along the inside, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun two to three wide for home and weakened in stretch. CAMPION LANE lost his footing at the start after being a bit fractious just prior, got coaxed along three to four wide towards the rear, swung five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. OFFICER MAHAFFY hustled from the start, got coaxed along inside on the pace until headed at the three-eighths, got spirited up further at the five-sixteenths, faded through the latter portion of the turn, cut the corner for home and tired in the drive. GRANVILLE'S WAY veered out at the start conceding about five lengths to the front, grew detached from the main body of the field early on and trailed throughout.
