Footnotes

STARSHIP CAPTAIN rode the rail for almost a half, got angled three wide into the stretch, quickly joined up with the front runners, vied outside a pair of foes for a sixteenth starting from outside the eighth pole, duelled with the runner up thereafter, closed in relentlessly and got there near the finish line. THE TRUTH AND K G settled along the inside after grabbing the advantage, was initially rated while cutting the pace, got pounced upon by MAJESTIC NUMBER as they headed for the quarter pole, was given his cue and responded positively, had the eventual winner make it a three-way tussle soon afterwards, sparred on even terms with the same foe for the final sixteenth only to yield with a couple jumps left. ALCOMATCH was steadied after getting pinched a couple of jumps after leaving the gate, was sluggish momentarily before getting going properly, tucked along the inside route well before reaching the end of the backstretch, remained along it throughout the run around the bend, began to pick up the pace with a furlong remaining, altered course starting from the sixteenth pole, concluded the maneuver in the four path, mustered up a strong but belated burst of speed to take the show award. REAL ESTATE was taken hold after bobbling at the break, saved ground to the quarter pole, was two wide and under encouragement at the top of the lane, got taken wider travelling through the furlong grounds, closed ground gradually. MAJESTIC NUMBER secured a forward position after the start, was under some urging midway along the backstretch, was kept to it upon entering the turn, latched on fully to the runner up as second fraction was being set, was forced to contend for command from between rivals from the furlong marker to the sixteenth pole, backed away when longer able to keep up that pursuit. MONEY ONLY pulled away from a foe at the start, raced along the outside, swung three wide into the stretch, had no response. SUPERIORITY gave chase from the two path, altered course a paths towards the outside in upper stretch, made no headway. SEEKER bobbed at the start, underwent a three pursuit, folded.
