Footnotes

MISSILE NICK placed to a hard hold while headstrong early on through the first turn, remained under a hold in a bit tight between and behind foes down the backside, got some room as ESSENCE OF A HERO backed out nearing the seven-sixteenths, got let out three furlongs out, bid three wide taking closer order on the front nearing the quarter pole, rallied to seize command at the three-sixteenths, drew away ridden out to the wire. PRIVATIZE ranged up to vie two to three wide leaving the clubhouse turn, took over five and a half furlongs out showing the way in hand down the backside, came under pressure into the far turn by NO NUKES, knocked heads with that foes through to the quarter pole coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch joined on the outside by MISSILE NICK, got headed for command at the three-sixteenths, proved no match for that foe through the final eighth while keeping on well clear for the place and second best. NO NUKES three to four wide in aim early on, began to apply some pressure to PRIVATIZE shifting to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, matched strides through the turn with that foe urged from the three-eighths, got joined outside by the eventual winner nearing the quarter pole, fought briefly between foes before weakening in the stretch. ALY'S FAVORITE BOY angled to the inside after the start, saved ground towards the rear, shifted to the two path to circle a foe in retreat at the seven-sixteenths, came under a ride three furlongs out, made no impact. TOM'S VISION broke awkwardly conceding about five lengths to the front, raced off inside towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home and offered little. ESSENCE OF A HERO spurted inside coaxed along on the front early on, was headed five and a half furlongs out, chased inside in aim to the half mile pole, began to retreat at the seven-sixteenths and tired.
