Footnotes

TIME MARCHES ON hustled from the gate, was coaxed along tracking the pacemakers while saving ground, gradually floated out in the turn to the two path midway, ended up three wide at the head of the lane while under a drive, closed in on the leg weary front in the final sixteenth under a drive being kept busy to the end. SKIDDLES N' BOB prompted the pace from the two path, was let out at the quarter pole, steadily gained in the final sixteenth when the leader got leg weary, was just up for place at the wire. NUMBER ONE CHERRY set the pace inside under some pressure, cut the corner into the stretch fully engaged by the rider, inched away by the eighth pole, began to weaken in the final sixteenth and was outfinished late by the top two while securing the show. STRATEGIC SUE bided time in midpack early on, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung into the lane in the two path, rallied mildly through the lane, appeared ready to angle out when beaten to the path by the winner in the latter stages of the stretch run, chose not to opt inside and was forced to steady off heels at the wire for the last major share. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL bumped lightly at the start with SIMPLE EXCHANGE, was outrun early on, saved ground to the quarter pole, rallied by tired rivals late when called upon. SIMPLE EXCHANGE bumped lightly at the start with KATY'S OFFICE GIRL, chased the pace from afar and was never involved. HOOKIN THE GOODS displayed brief foot while three wide most of the way and gave way after a half. There was a STEWARDS' INQUIRY focusing on the second, third and fourth finishers nearing the wire before the result was declared official.
