KATMANSTU established control in short order and was guided over to the inside, had the rider keep something in reserve while showing the way on a loosely-contested lead for nearly a half, fleetingly felt some pressure arriving at the five-sixteenths pole and was soon called upon in response, skipped off to be in possession of his biggest advantage with a furlong to go, held on well enough in the late stages to prevail. MUSCLES MARINARA chased the top one from near the two path, was already under encouragement turning for home, gained ground steadily in the final furlong. MORE HUNDRED ACRE raced three wide on both turns, mustered up a mild response for the show award. DAPPER DRAPER forwardly placed in three path, weakened. COMMODUS broke to the outside, failed to be a factor. CANDY RAIDER saved ground for six furlongs, commenced the stretch four wide, made no headway. DUCKS DOCK swung four wide into the stretch, had no offering. CRAQUI got steadied after coming out slightly at the start, was sluggish during the early going, spun three wide into the lane, tired. STONE ROCKS tracked the front runners while placed along the inside route, got roused past the three-eighths pole, failed to pick up the pace and faltered.
