KHAN OF KHANS left alertly and quickly made the lead, was responding to the rating tactics being applied by the rider when he jumped over an object in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, recovered from that incident and continued to set the pace, placed two wide for the run around the bend, began to edge away from the competition prior to the quarter pole before being called upon, emerged from the eighth pole holding his biggest advantage, showed signs of weariness from his earlier efforts with about a sixteenth to go, held safely for the decision. POWER KING got off a beat slowly, beating only a tardier MR. DR. PROFESSOR leaving the starting gate, was put to some hand urging and settled into midpack, travelled three wide for most of the way around the turn, closed in with good energy on the weakening leader in the final furlong en route for the place. ZONE BREAKER took the inside route until deep stretch and held well for the show. BRUNELLI outrun for nearly a half while racing along the outside, altered course at the eighth pole and rallied mildly to grab the last major check. SYSTEM RESTORE stumbled at the start, took the overland route around the turn and was no menace. STORM ISLAND three wide departing the backstretch, was urged along chasing the winner, left the five-sixteenths pole under a full drive and soon backed away. BOLD VINDICATION a brief factor, raced in the four path on the turn. VALUE ADDED TAX underwent a four wide pursuit and folded. MR. DR. PROFESSOR got off the slowest

of all after lunging at the break, cut the corner into the lane, briefly improved position then tired.
