SHMOOZ TALKER off the inside, picked up the pace coming to the end of the turn, fanned five wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and closed in readily, lost none of his momentum departing the eighth pole, collaring a resilient leader prior to the wire to prove best. BELLAMY out broke the field by a half a beat, had multiple rivals join up soon afterwards, to be momentarily the innermost member of a line of four, edged away along with SAINTS ALIVE and good hooked up a protracted duel that lasted until the furlong grounds, was the first of the pair to have the pilot commit to some kind of urging, doing so by the quarter pole, kicked clear for a brief period with an eighth to go, felt the top one presence, offered good resistance before yielding reluctantly. GALAXY KAT rode the rail until midstretch, was already under solid urging cutting the corner into the lane, angled outward sharply to be placed outside the front runners, rallied willingly to secure the show. DADDY'S WILDCAT underwent a four wide pursuit, tired. SAINTS ALIVE sparred with the runner up from the outside for slightly over a half before giving way. PRO'S PAL left the half mile pole three wide and gave chase from out there nearly the whole way around the bend, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but only for several strides, had the rider switch tactics to a combination of taps with the stick on the right shoulder and a strong grip on the left rein, tired after entering the stretch. EZZY out a couple of steps at the break, raced from well of the rail, drifted four wide into the lane while tiring.
