THIS ONES FOR NINA came inward slightly and bumped with the nearest opponent, chased the loose leader from off the inside, got set down heading for the stretch, poked a head down in front with an eighth to go, had the runner up latch on to loom a serious threat shortly after doing it, dug in well to fend that rival off. M P RUCKUS was bumped solidly from between rivals at the start, raced from off the inside, closed in readily after entering the stretch, drew directly alongside the winner just past the furlong grounds, loomed boldly but failed to go by. VENGEFUL PRIDE was one of many involved in a bumping incident as the field was sent on its way, getting knocked sideways after having contact made, was gradually taken inward, got placed briefly in tight quarters midway down the backstretch, settled into midpack by the half mile pole and remained there for the next quarter, was swung five wide into the lane, came home with good energy to grab the show. CIRCADIA saved ground in the initial stages, and mustered up a mild response good enough for the final major slice of the pot. SAY LANCELOT raced along the outside and went on to improve position. CHEROKEE CREEK off slowly, failed to menace off a ground-saving journey. FISH HOOKS bumped from both sides at the start, had no rally. MOONSHINE RIDGE set the pace from the two path, squandered a comfortable advantage during the run through the furlong grounds and gave way. UPTOWN BALL tracked inside and faltered. RUNNING MADE EASY bumped from between foes at the break, was never in contention. ITS WHAT I DO bumped from between foes at the start, chased weakly from the outside

and tired.
